Did you know? In 1797, Yeomanry threatened to destroy the mud chapel in Derrylin. Mrs Mary Gunn (Barney) ran to Captain Smith who lived in Callowhill for help. Mary's daughter, Nora was employed as a nurse in the captain's house. Captain Smith not only prevented the occurrence but he gave the people of Derrylin an acre of land to build a stone church on. It is now known as St. Ninnidh's Church.
