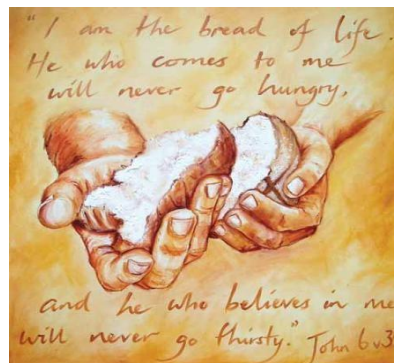
The Cross requires the exodus of Jesus, his death, Resurrection & glorification.
