Pope Francis has declared Sunday 17 November 2024 to be the eighth World Day of the Poor, with the theme of "The prayer of the poor rises up to God."

The expression that gives the 2024 World Day of the Poor its theme is taken from the Book of Sirach (cf. *Sir* 21:5). In his message for this World Day of the Poor, the Holy Father reiterates that "the poor hold a privileged place in God's heart" and invites everyone to learn to pray for the poor and to pray together with the poor, with humility and trust.

OPEN THE DOORS OF MY HEART

God of Abraham,
on my television,
on my newsfeed,
on my street,
everywhere I go,
I see Lazarus.
But I also see so many doors,
doors that I've built,
that I've closed.
Doors that society has hung and locked.
