Weekend 1st & 2nd February 2025 The Presentation of the Lord

- 2. For all the children of our world, that they may be loved and cherished by their families and by the societies in which they live. *Lord, hear us.*
- 3. For all who live under the constant threat of violence and the shadow of war, that all people will turn from violence to peace. *Lord, hear us.*
- 4. For all young people who are preparing this year for their First Holy Communion or to receive the sacrament of Confirmation, that they will always keep Jesus at the centre of their lives. *Lord, hear us.*

Weekend 8th & 9th February 2025
