His daughter, Celia went to the island shore and shouted continuously for help. Her cries for help were heard on the mainland and emergency services were contacted. A naval helicopter from Ballykelly, Co. Derry was dispatched. The helicopter landed alongside Knockninny Hotel to collect medical supplies, food & gas and then went to Inishlarroo Island.
